

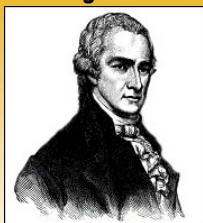

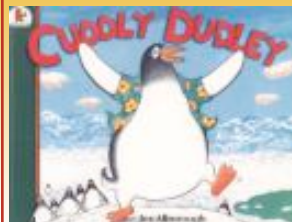

Each person over the age of 2 MUST be indicated on the form and pay for camping. The NCHF organization is required to pay Lake Francis for each person attending.

Please do NOT Contact Lake Francis for camping or cabin rentals for Friday and Saturday of the festival. The NCHF will be taking care of all camping and cabin rentals when registration opens. and they will be monitoring and checking campers in. Tent and RV sites are intermixed in the campground, so RV sites will be marked reserved. Tent sites will be first come, first serve at the Resort, NOT in advance. All RV sites will be assigned on arrival.

If you plan to come Thursday or early you must pay to stay. Please contact Lake Francis directly if you want to come early or stay beyond the festival.
