WZZ Barrel Project #2

Just wanted to put in a little info again about both barrel projects. All the Russian Imperial Stout has been removed from the barrel and given back to the rightful owners. It turned out to be a great success, very flavorful bourbon character but it doesn't lose the complexity of the Russian Imperial Stout style. It is still very young for this style and should age gracefully. I will try to bring a sample from my stash to the meeting for others to try.

For Project #2 we have discussed brewing a Belgian Dark Strong and aging that in the same barrel. The barrel does not have much bourbon character left, most of it in the RIS was added bourbon. If you would like to brew this, in this barrel, you MUST let us **know. NOW!** If we do not get enough interest in this we will most likely not be able to use this barrel again. We are planning on buying another barrel if that happens and split the cost between the members that want to be involved but the new barrel will only be 30 gallons and we only need 6 people to brew 5 gallons each. Yes, this will limit participation but since there is none, except for the previous members involved, it doesn't matter.


